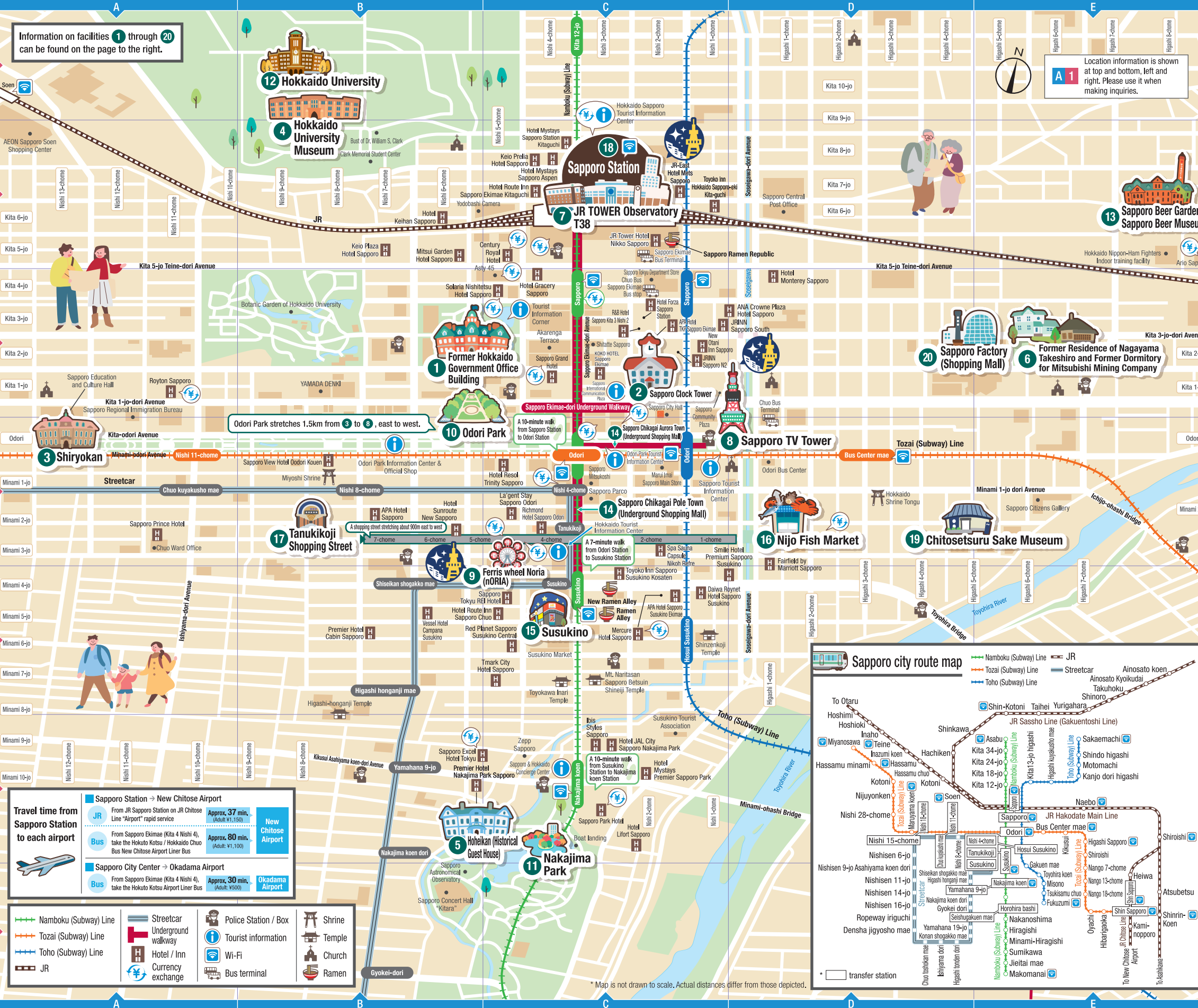

Formally recognized as having one of "Japan's New Three Most Spectacular Night Views," Sapporo is packed with spots to enjoy its nighttime skyline, a vista on a scale that's all Hokkaido. Sapporo's sweeping panorama can be viewed from Mt. Moiwa and other mountains surrounding the city. But you can also enjoy the night views from spots within Sapporo, including the TV Tower, the Ferris wheel and observation decks atop many buildings. A rich variety of view points let you enjoy night vistas that are representative of Japan!

In Sapporo, skiing is within an hour of downtown! Only in Sapporo can you ski and see the sights together. There are six ski grounds to choose from, ranging in appeal from kid-friendly slopes safe and fun for beginners to full-on runs for those who want to enjoy fresh powder to the max. Pick the ski ground that's just right for you!



Area guide

Hokuto area

By subway, bus, etc. from Sapporo Station 25-40 min.

POINT! There are many parks for the whole family to enjoy. Okadama Airport is easily accessible from the city center.

Nishi area

By subway, etc., from Sapporo Station 30-40 min.

POINT! You can enjoy skiing and mountain climbing in the range dominated by Mt. Teine.

Shin-Sapporo area

By JR, bus, etc., from Sapporo Station 20-30 min.

POINT! Redevelopment continues in Sapporo's urban sub-center. It's easy to stop by when moving between New Chitose Airport and the city center.

Minami area

By subway, bus, etc., from Sapporo Station 35-55 min.

POINT! Plenty of spots where you can encounter art and nature.
